Product Introduction

- The newly designed U.S. Solid USS-BSW00008 high-frequency inversion battery spot welder equips with the six super capacitors for energy storage and power supply for pulse welding. Unlike traditional AC transformer spot welders, it does not cause any interference to the electric circuit, eliminating tripping problems.
- <u>The low-consumption super energy-gathered millisecond pulse technology</u> maximizes the pulse energy output in millisecond-level time, the welding spot is excellent and no damage to the battery.
- <u>42KW/7000A Super Welding Output</u> Supporting the large-capacity power battery of copper/aluminum terminals welding.
- <u>LED Display Screen & Controlling Buttons</u> Real-time capacitor voltage, charging current, power grade and actual welding current parameters are monitored. Convenient parameter adjustments can be made by pressing the buttons.
- <u>'AT/MT' Two Welding Modes</u> 'AT' automatic mode for quick welding and 'MT' foot pedal controlling mode for beginners or precise welding.
- <u>Multiple welding pen accessories</u> are available for different welding requirements. (*Please notice that the package only contains the default 75A-Plus welding pen for large-capacity power battery welding, additional purchase required for other-types welding pen*)
- The newly added 'Welding Spot Resistance Milliohm Meter' function allows for quick measurement of the resistance between the connecting piece and electrodes of the battery after spot welding. The lower the resistance, the better the welding effect, and it provides a convenient way to check for poor welding spots.

Usage Scenarios

Lithium battery pack quick building & maintenance for electric appliances, electric vehicles, etc.

Especially designed for the large-capacity power battery aluminum/copper terminals welding.

Circuit Board/Hardware/Electronic Components/Lead Wire spot welding.

(Tips: Different welding pen accessories additional purchase required, the package only includes the 75A-Plus welding pen for large battery welding).

Widely used for the common metal welding like stainless steel, iron, nickel, copper, aluminum, titanium, molybdenum, etc.

- 'SD' Lights up after the machine is on standby for 30 mins
- 'PT' Lights up when there is a short circuit in the machine
- Charging Current Real-time Charging Current(5-20 A)
- 'DCV' Real-time Capacitor Voltage(0-6 V)
- 'KA' Real-time Output Current

How To Use

Usage Diagram



1. Plug in the power cord and connect to the right power supply. (*Tips: Confirm the power supply and plug type*)



2. Switch on the machine.



Wait for the capacitor voltage to reach 5.6-6V.
(*Tips: 1. The machine has been discharged to the lowest voltage before leaving the factory for safety transportation, charge the machine firstly for first time use.* <u>2. Machine will make normal sounds when charging.</u>)



4. Plug in the 75A-plus separated-style welding pen.



5. Secure the connection by screwing in the set screws tightly.



6. Press the 'or' button to start the parameter setting.



7. Press the ' →' buttons to switch the power grade adjustment or welding modes selection.



Press the '▲ ↓' buttons to adjust the power grade values or select 'AT/MT' welding modes.



9. Press the '**C**' button again to save all settings and exit. (*Tips: The parameter settings are not saved when screen displays the flickering values, press the* '**C**' button to confirm the adjustment.)

10. Shut down the machine when not using and unplug it.

'AT' - Automatic Welding Mode



Set the 'AT' mode

Apply enough and uniform pressure on two welding electrodes, the welding pulse will be triggered in 300ms delayed time

<u>'MT' - Foot Pedal Controlling Mode</u>









Set the 'MT' mode

de Plug in the foot pedal Apply enough and uniform Check the welding effect switch pressure on two welding electrodes, step on the pedal switch and welding pulse is triggered instantly

Notes:

- 1. 'AT' automatic mode is for quick welding and 'MT' foot pedal controlling mode is for the beginner or precise welding. The welding effect needs to be checked in AT quick welding mode to avoid the neglected bad welding spots.
- Apply enough and uniform pressure on two welding electrodes to get the welding pieces and welding surface fully contacted for optimal welding effect. (Apply different pressure according to different materials and thickness).
- 3. Not enough pressure applied on the welding electrodes or slow operation exceeding the 300ms pulse delayed time in 'AT' mode will cause large sparks.

Special Notice for Welding Effect Test of Large-capacity Batteries of Aluminum Terminals



Because the aluminum metal is softer than stainless steel and copper, so the welding effect test method of batteries of aluminum terminals is different. The welding pieces should be <u>flat pulled but not torn off</u> because the metal joints cannot hold the pulling force.

Welding Spot Resistance Milliohm Meter



1. Press the ' ${f U}$ ' button to turn on the function



2. Plug in the milliohm measuring pen





 Measure the resistance between the connecting piece and the electrode of battery after spot welding



Notes:

1. Assisting in efficiently inspecting poor welding spots in 'AT' welding mode.

2. Electriferous objects like battery cannot be measured.

3. The lower resistance, the better welding effect, which means the better battery pack performance.

Notes:

- 1. Clean or replace the welding electrodes regularly for optimal welding effect.
- 2. Lubricating oil can be smeared on the welding electrodes to prevent oxidization.

3. The package only contains the default 75A-Plus welding pen for large-capacity power battery welding, additional purchase required for other-types welding pen.

Usage Notices

- Precious metals like gold, silver and jewelry cannot be welded.
- Never contact the two welding electrodes of welding pen.
- Never contact the battery positive and negative terminals at the same time.
- Do not set the power grade too high, otherwise will cause large sparks and penetrate the battery.
- Welding sparks may occur, wear goggles and keep a safe distance.
- Charge the machine firstly for first time use and wait the capacitor voltage reaches 5.6-6V. (*The machine has been discharged to the lowest voltage before leaving the factory for safety transportation*).
- 'AT' automatic mode is for quick welding and 'MT' foot pedal controlling mode is for the beginner or precise welding. The welding effect needs to be checked in AT quick welding mode to avoid the neglected bad welding spots.
- Apply enough and uniform pressure on two welding electrodes to get the welding pieces and welding surface fully contacted for optimal welding effect. (Apply different pressure according to different materials and thickness).
- Keep the welding pieces and welding surface clean and flat to avoid poor welding effect.
- Clean or replace the welding electrodes regularly for optimal welding effect.
- Twist and tighten the welding electrodes firmly for best conductivity.
- Do not take down the plastic shell of the welding pen.
- Lubricating oil can be smeared on the welding electrodes to prevent oxidization.
- The package list only contains the default 75A-Plus welding pen for large-capacity power battery welding, additional purchase required for other-types welding pen.
- Only use the welding accessories(welding pen, electrodes) from U.S. Solid.
- Only charge the machine with the original power cord.
- Keep the mahcine plugged in for working.
- Normal meter cannot measure the actual instant welding current(pulse).
- The milliohm meter function cannot measure the electriferous object(battery).
- Shut down the mahcine when not using and unplug it.
- Do not take part and modify the machine personally, doing so may cause danger.
- Do not use the mahcine if lacking of related knowledge and experience.
- Do not use in inflammable, explosive dangerous environments.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Special Notice for Welding Effect Test of Large-capacity Batteries of Aluminum Terminals

Because the aluminum metal is softer than stainless steel and copper, so the welding effect test method of batteries of aluminum terminals is different. The welding pieces should be <u>flat</u> <u>pulled but not torn off</u> because the metal joints cannot hold the pulling force.

	internal circuit board broken (machine short circuit: contact the welding pen two electrodes; contact the battery positive and negative terminals at the same time)	replace new circuit board	
Error Type - 'E02'	step on the pedal switch always or too fast	step by interval time	
triggered in short time)	the pedal switch is broken(stuck)	repair or replace new pedal switch	
	low capacitor voltage	charge and wait the voltage reaches 5.6-6V	
Weak Welding	set the power grade too low	turn up the power grade	
	welding pen or its welding electrodes not plugged in firmly	check the connection	
Large Wolding Spark	not enough pressure applied on the welding pieces	apply enough pressure	
Large weiging spark	exceed the pulse delayed time	quicken the welding operation
